



MAKING LEMONADE

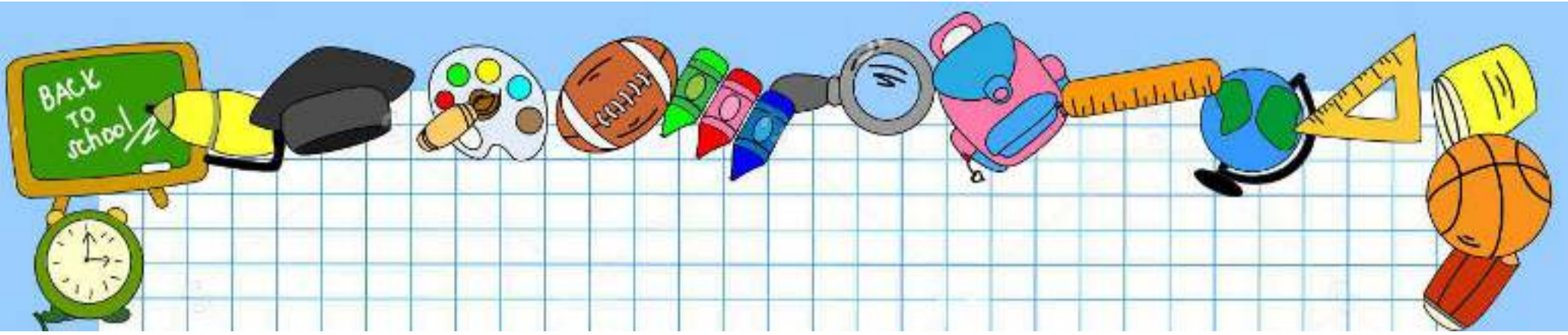

SPLASH POOL

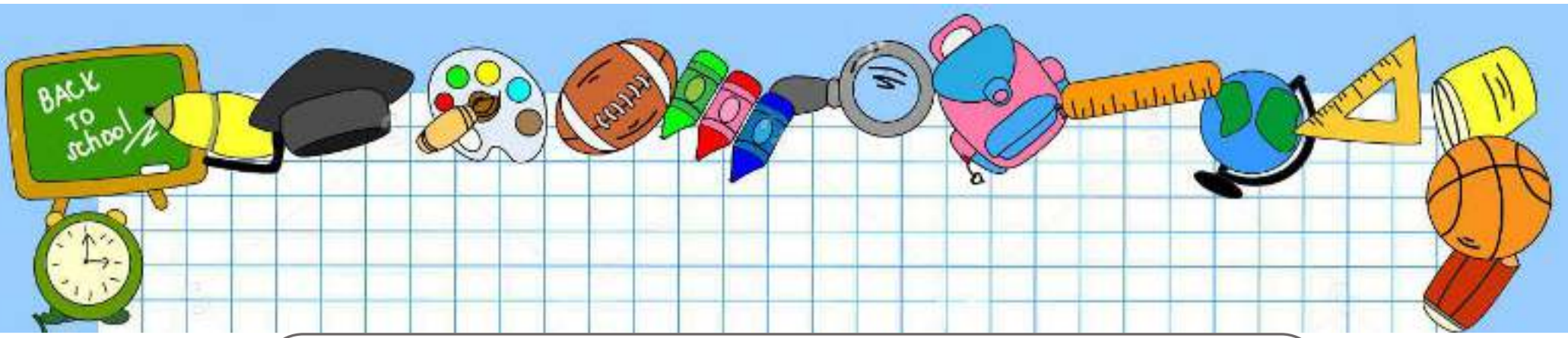
