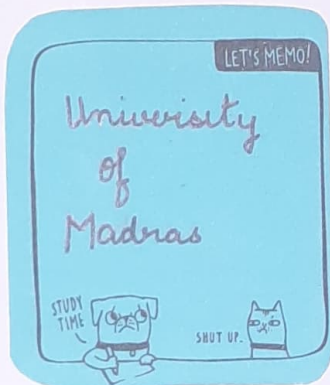
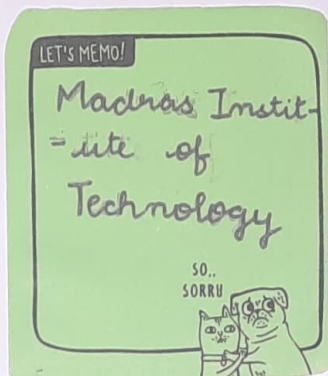
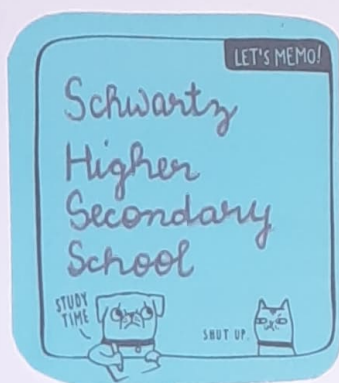


ABOUT

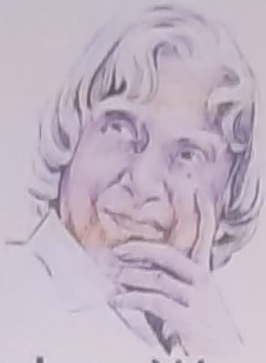

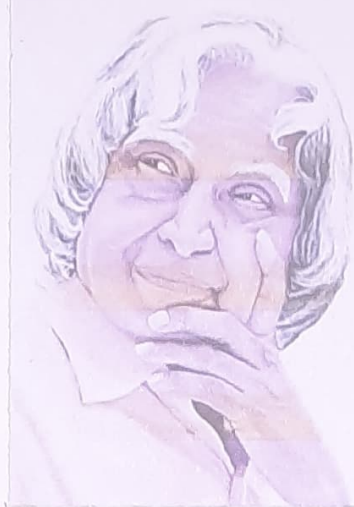
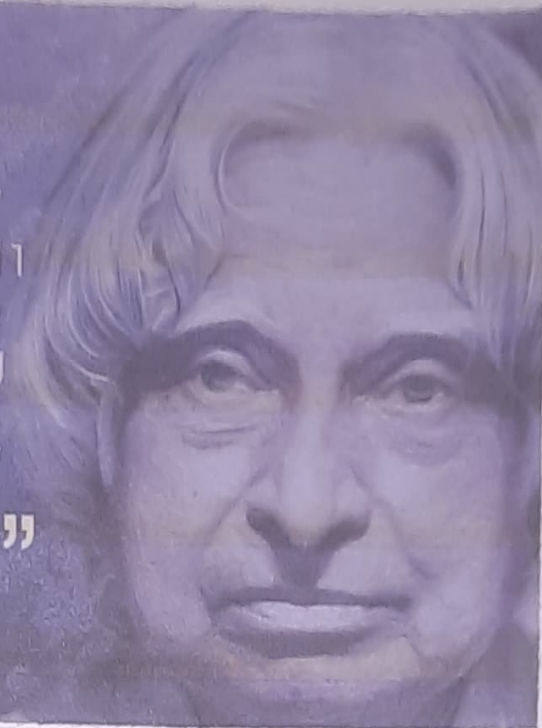
