Therefore, they shared their pictures while performing the activity.




"Our Wonderful Earth"



The students of grade 2 made different collages on Earth. They were very happy to do this activity and made beautiful collages. They also learnt that earth is round in shape and has land, air and water.


"Types of Landforms - Virtual tour"

Variation in Temperature

The students of grade 9 performed two activities in which they studied the variation in temperature of various media like water filled beaker, empty jar and beaker filled with soil. All these containers were kept in sunlight for around 3 hours and their temperatures were measured. Also, the temperature was measured after keeping it in shade. The observation revealed that both sand and water don't heat up at the same rate.

The second activity which they performed was related to the study of the nature of convection currents. It was observed that warm air rises up and the smoke moves towards the low pressure area.
