"Palm Printing"



The students of grade 2 made various things by palm printing. They made beautiful and creative drawings of peacocks, trees, clouds, hens, butterflies, etc.


Culture and Dance forms of Andhra Pradesh

True North- 'Character Building Programme'

Through this programme, we focus on an education that incorporates values, ethics, emotional maturity and a sense of civics (through various activities/games/ challenges). The following activities were done during the month of January. The character traits taken are 'Self-Control' & 'Honesty':

Self-Control:

1. Word Chain: The teacher starts with word. The children must remember the words said previously and think of unique words to add.

2. Dance Party Freeze: One child is the leader and others follow his steps. When the music stops, everyone freezes and then, the there is new leader and it continues.

3. Color Freeze: This is also similar to the very common 'Freeze Dance'. The only difference is that when the music stops, the teacher says a color and children have to quickly get anything of that colour within 10 seconds.

4. Guard Duty: One child becomes the (Queen's)guard for the palace. They have a mission to be as serious and guard-like as possible. That means using self-control and ignoring anyone who tries to distract you!

Honesty:

Snakes and Ladders: This is a version of the ancient game of Snakes and Ladders, originally used as a moral teaching tool in India. This game is a playful way to initiate discussions on ethical issues, moral values, and behaviour.
Tell a truth and Tell a lie: For every question asked, the child will give one wrong answer and one right. The other children will guess which is correct/true.
Honesty Board Game (Name 3 things): Children roll a dice and answer the question given on the number they get.
