“All Human Beings are Equal”



Article 17 of the Indian Constitution states that untouchability is abolished and its practice in any form is forbidden. The enforcement of any disability arising out of untouchability shall be a punishable offence in accordance with law.

Untouchability refers to a social practice which looks down upon certain depressed classes solely on account of their birth and makes any discrimination against them on this ground. Their physical touch was considered to pollute others. Such castes which were called untouchables were not allowed to draw water from the same well, or use the pond/tank which was being used by the higher castes. They were not allowed to enter some temples and suffered many other disabilities. The students of grade 6 made posters which displayed the message of abolishing untouchability and other evil practices like Child Labour and Save Girl Child as a part of fun with learning in Civics chapter ‘All Human Beings are Equal’.
