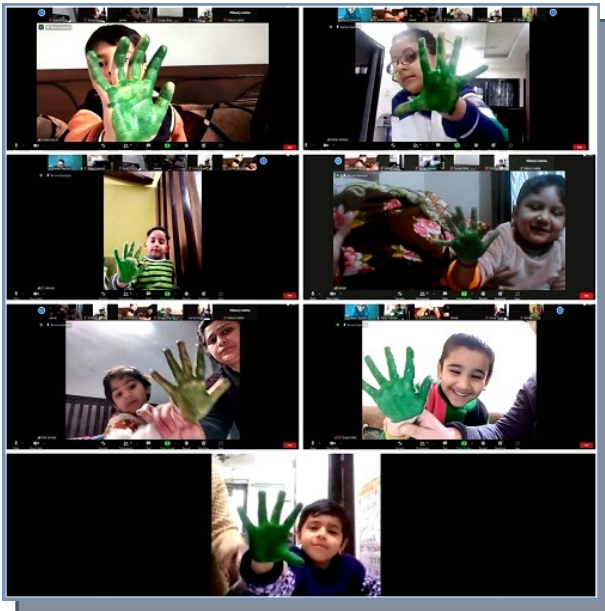
Sharing and Caring
