Did you hear it go clink, clink, clink?






**True North: Sharing & Caring**

#### **Shape: Diamond**




Diamond is not just a diamond, it can be sweets, flowers or kites as well. Foundation students learned 'kite making with earbud printing' to know the diamond shape.
