## EXAMINATION POLICY GRADE IX & X

## Assessment of student's learning:

Periodic Tests: There will be three cumulative periodic tests in a year. Best 2 scores out of 3 periodic tests will be taken and converted to 5.

- Final Evaluation will be based on Annual Examination (80 marks) & Internal Assessment (20 marks).
- For promotion to next higher class, it is mandatory to appear in all the assessments and score at least 33% marks in Internal (20%) and Annual (80%).
- Co-Scholastic Areas (Art Education, Physical and Health Education, SEWA and Discipline) will be assessed internally on a five point scale (A – E).
   Minimum qualifying grade is D.



# EXAMINATION POLICY GRADE IX AND X CONT....



- Annual Exam in class-X will be conducted at board designated
   Examination Centre covering entire syllabus of class-X.
- Annual Exam in class-IX will be conducted in school covering entire syllabus of class-IX.
- There is a provision of opting Mathematics Basic and Mathematics Standard in class X.
- Mock tests will be conducted for practice before final exams of class IX and Pre-board exam will be conducted in class X for better preparation of Board exams.
- Internal assessment: 20 marks

Theory examination: 80 marks
