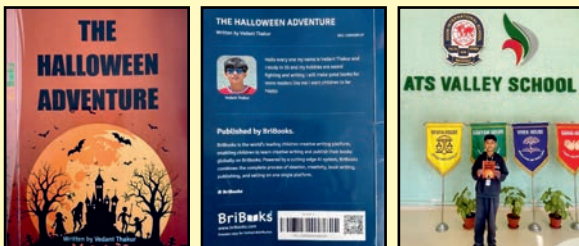
✓ CONFIDENCE, CHARM AND A STEP TOWARDS STARDOM

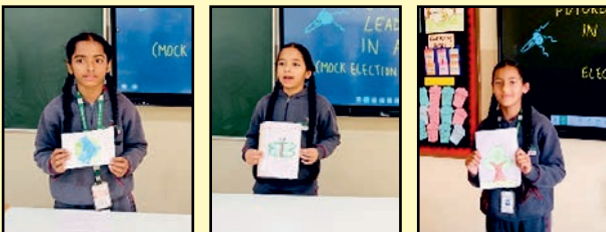
✓ PROUD ACHIEVEMENT A YOUNG AUTHOR IN THE MAKING

As the indicator reacted with the base, the message magically appeared in bright pink colour. This experiment helped students understand acid-base reactions and the role of indicators in Chemistry, proving that learning science can be both fun and fascinating.

✓ UNITED NATIONS GENERAL ASSEMBLY SIMULATION

GRADES IV AND VI

Students of Grades IV and VI participated in a 'Symmetry paper folding activity'. They folded paper to create symmetrical shapes and designs. This hands-on activity helped them understand the concept of symmetry and its applications. Students enjoyed exploring lines of symmetry and creating their own patterns. The activity encouraged creativity and spatial reasoning. It was a fun way to learn about symmetry!



✓ CURIOSITY BASED LEARNING SESSION

A curiosity-based learning session was conducted for Grade V students to help them understand scientific concepts through hands-on experimentation and learning by doing. The focus of the session was on chemical reactions, introduced in an age-appropriate and engaging manner.

Students performed simple experiments using everyday materials such as baking soda (sodium bicarbonate) and apple, which helped them relate classroom learning to real life. Under proper guidance, they used test tubes and followed basic laboratory procedures while wearing lab coats and safety goggles, giving them a real laboratory experience. The session created a sense of excitement and enthusiasm among the students and helped them develop curiosity, scientific thinking and love for science.

(19th - 24th January 2026)

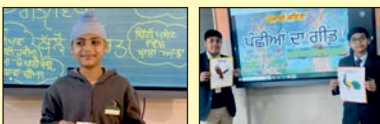

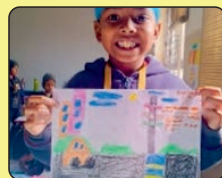

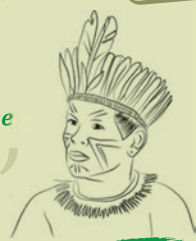

A group of students visits a tribal village in Madhya Pradesh. The Baiga and Gond heads warmly welcome them to their village.

Yashvin: Namaste Uncles! We have read about your tribes in our school books. Can you tell us more about your history and way of life?

Bhola (Baiga Head): Namaste, children. I am Bhola the head of the Baiga tribe. The Baigas are one of the oldest tribes.

Yashvin: Sir, what does Baiga mean?

Bhola: Baiga means 'sorcerer-medicine man', as we are spiritual healers, priests, and we practice magic also.

Yashvin: Oh yes, in our chapter we read that Baigas are healers.

Bhola: We have Gunia and Tonahi, our traditional healers.



Gunias use a combination of herbal medicines and spiritual rituals like Jhad Phook with the chant of sacred mantras. Tonahi is a woman who possesses mysterious power control supernatural forces.

Yashvin: Ohh! That sounds scary.

Bhola: Don't worry. We do it only for the benefit of our community. Gonds also consult us in the matters of health, agriculture, and spirituality.

Ratan (Gond Head): We Gonds too have a long history. We are known for our vibrant art, rich folklore, and deep reverence for nature.

Aarav: Yes sir, we've heard that your tribes live very close to nature. Can you tell us how?

Bhola: We have a spiritual connection with nature. We call earth 'Dharti Mata'. We practice Bewar farming which is a type of slash-and-burn agriculture. We grow millets like Kodo, Kutki, Mahua, and Bajra.



Himani: And what about your traditions, Bhola ji?

Bhola: Our women have special tattoos 'Godna', that tell us about their identity and culture. These tattoos are made with vegetable-based dyes and serve as permanent adornment.



We also love our Karma dance, which is performed around a tree branch to celebrate life and the changing seasons.

Himani: Sir, where is your temple? We want to see that.

Bhola: For us, the forest is our temple. We worship Bada Deo and other local gods under trees.

Ratan: We also worship Bada Deo and our ancestors' spirits.

Himani: What is Bada Deo?

Ratan: Bada Deo is our creator who is believed to reside in the 'Saja' tree.

Himani: Your traditions are full of respect for nature.

Bhola: Yes. We believe in balanced and interconnected existence.

Ratan: May the present and future generations also value and preserve the nature, rather than merely seeing it as a resource.

Bhola: That's true. The forest gives us life and therefore we must conserve them.

Ratan: We wish that everyone learns from us - to live simply, respect the earth, and stay united.

Aarav: Thank you Sir! We will never forget the lessons of the Baigas and Gonds - to live in harmony with people and nature and the resilience of the communities.
