# Holistic Progress Card

## HPC- for Foundational Stage

- for ages 3-8, Bal Vatika to Grade 2
- a 360-degree, descriptive assessment tool designed by PARAKH (NCERT)
- evaluates a child's development across physical, cognitive, socio-emotional, and aesthetic domains.
- replaces numerical marks with qualitative, play-based observations.

## LSRW

- the foundational four-skill approach to language acquisition and communication
- input first (listening/reading) followed by output (speaking/writing)—to build comprehensive proficiency, starting with auditory comprehension, progressing to verbal expression, literacy, and final communication through writing.

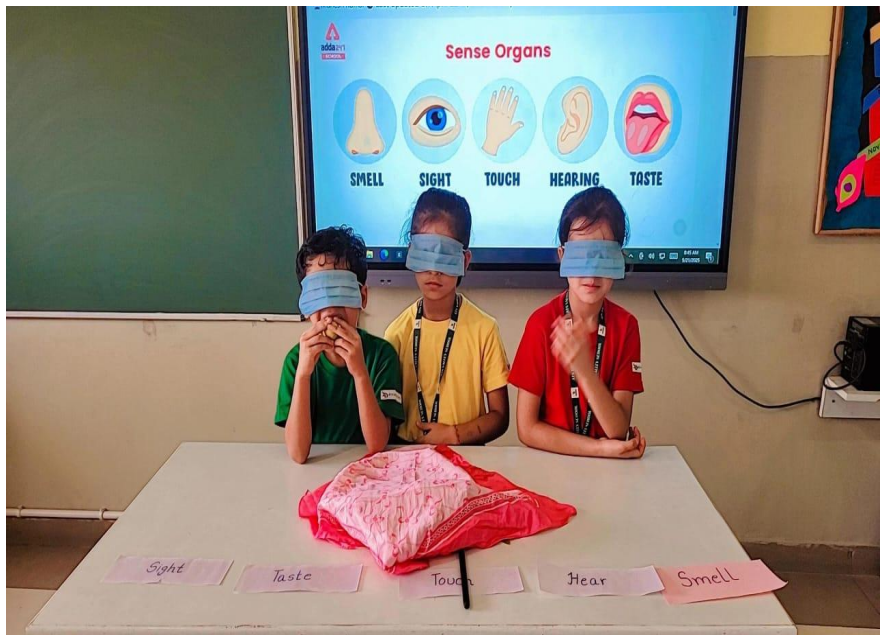






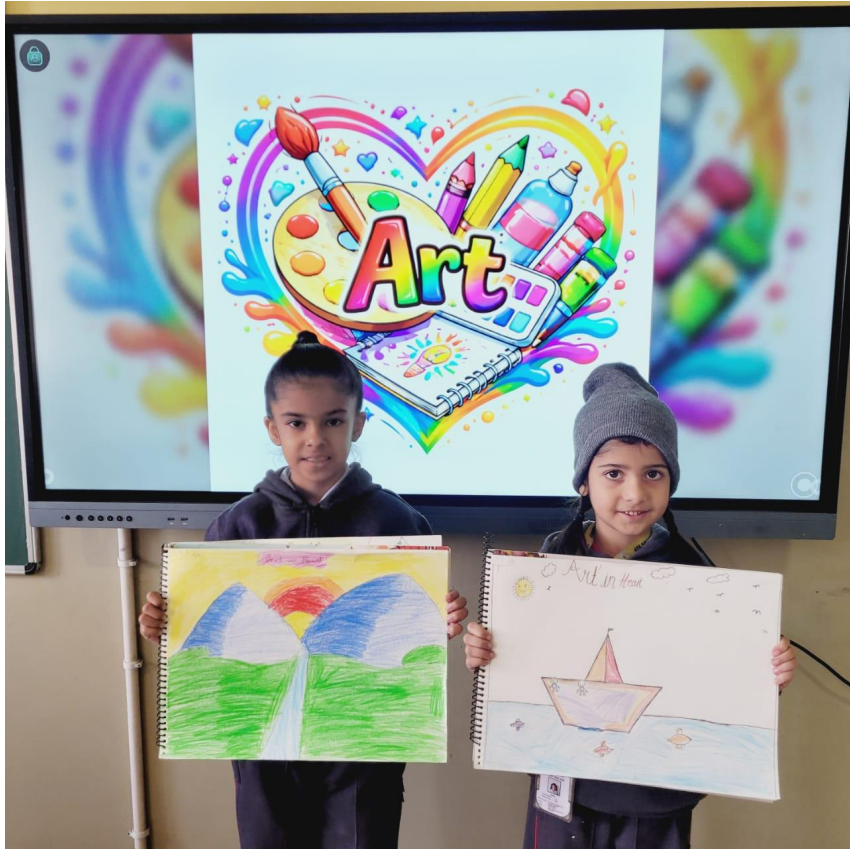














# Let them EXPLORE, LEARN & LEAD
