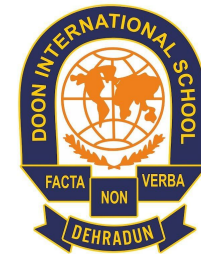

Most of the brain development happens in the first five years of life, with 90% of brain development occurring by age 5.

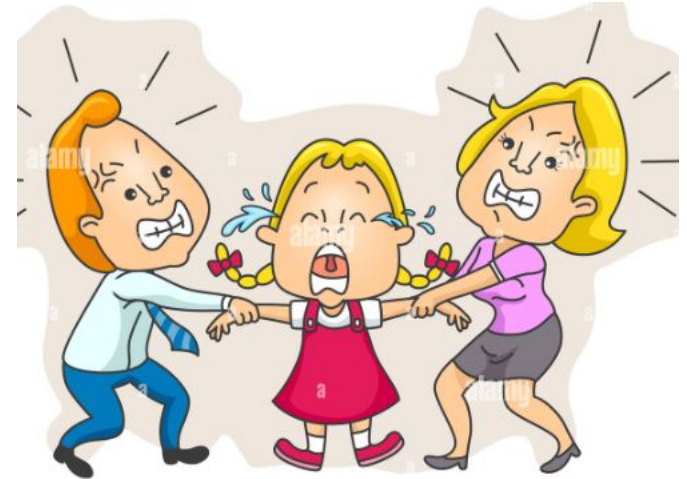
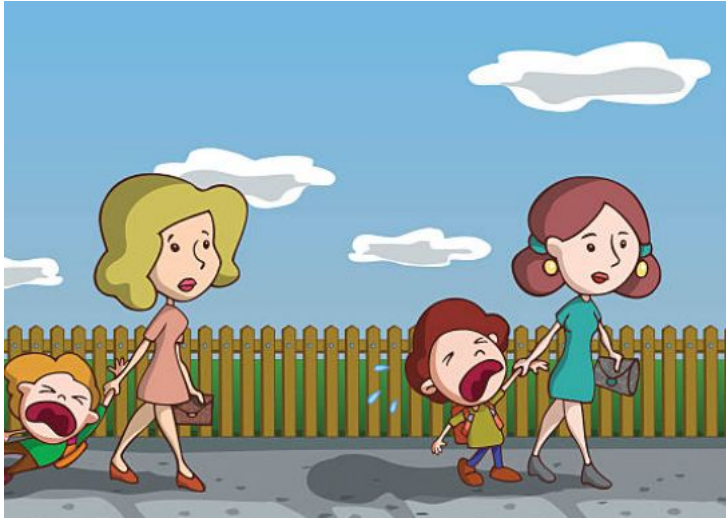

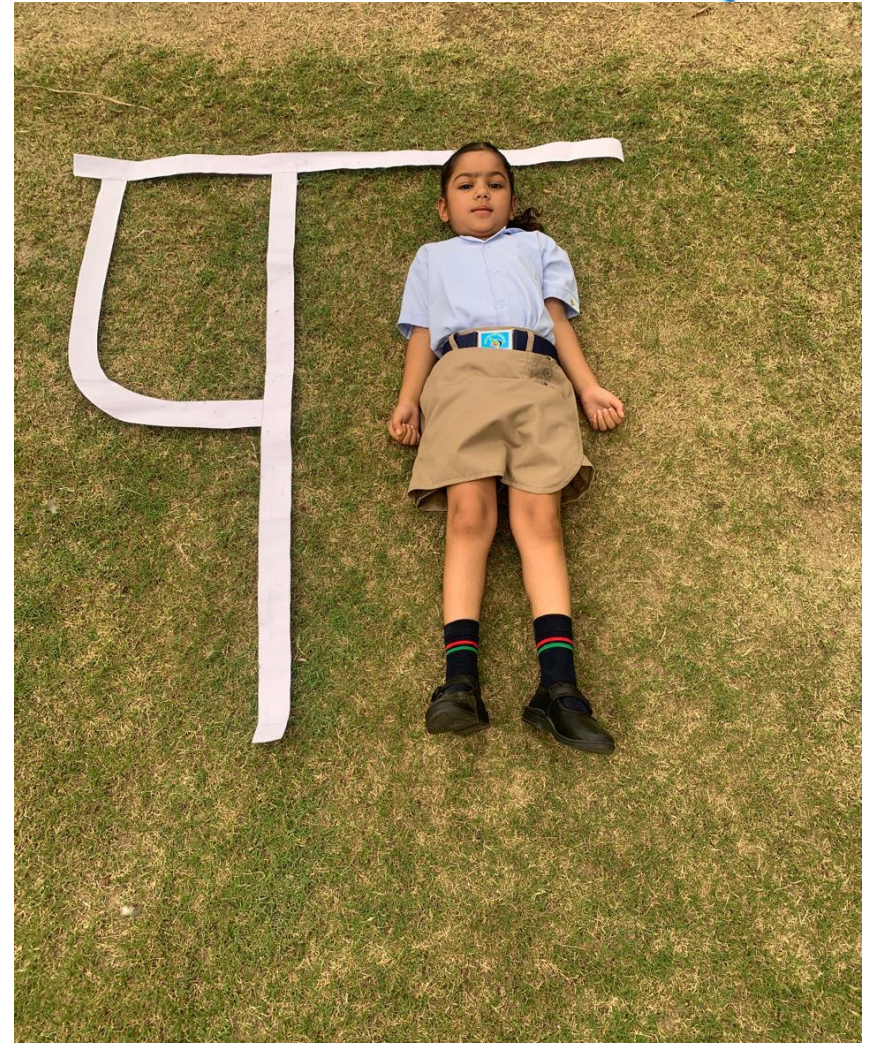
