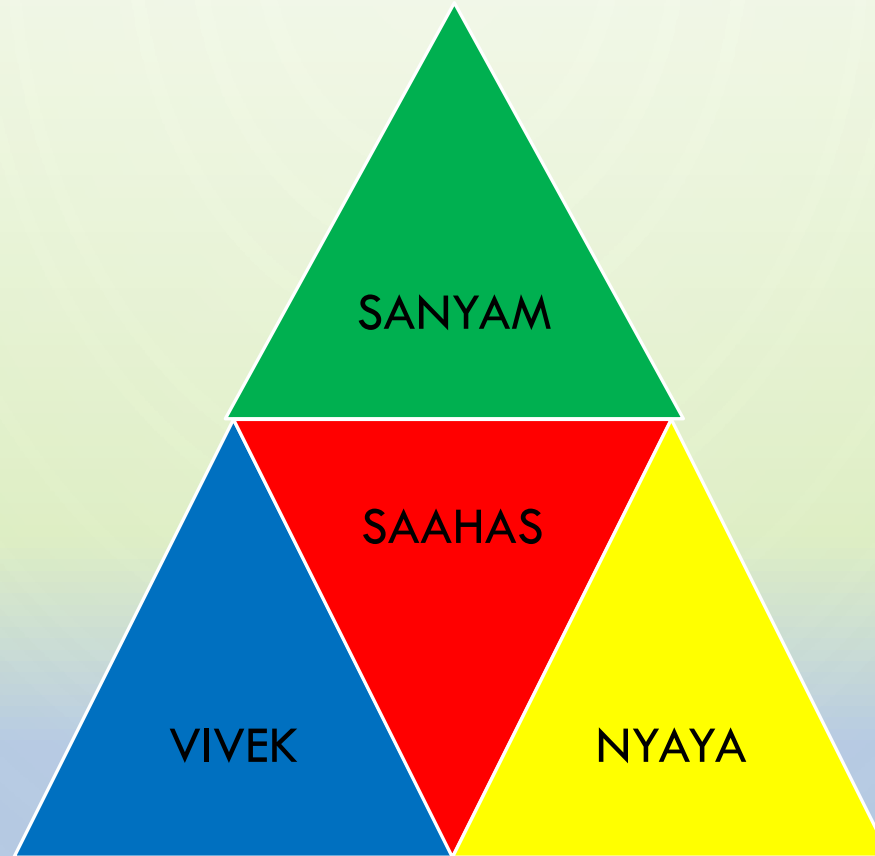

- Shoes- Plain black, laced, normal heel, rubber sole
- Patka (if applicable) Sky blue(matching with shirt colour) and school belt

GRADE VI to X

- Shirt-sky blue, half sleeved, tie collared, front buttoned
- Skirts-Beige color, knee length dividers
- Socks- navy blue with two stripes (red and green) on the border
- Shoes- Plain black, laced, normal heel, rubber sole
- Hair- The girls have to tie their hair neatly with black bands or ribbons

EXAMINATION POLICY VI-VIII

Assessment of student's learning:

TERM 1 (Comprises of Unit-1 and Half Yearly exam)

- Unit Test: 30 marks (Assessment of syllabus covered in April and May)
- Half Yearly (Assessment of syllabus covered from April to September)

Internal assessment: 20 marks
Theory examination: 80 marks

EXAMINATION POLICY VI-VIII

TERM II: (Comprises of Unit II and Annual Exam).

- Unit Test: 30 marks
- Annual Exam (Assessment of syllabus covered from September to February & as per CBSE a small portion of syllabus covered in Term I will also be tested).

10% syllabus of Term-1 for VI
20% syllabus of Term-1 for VII
30% syllabus of Term-1 for VIII

Internal assessment: 20 marks
Theory examination: 80 marks

- Mock tests will be conducted for practice before final exams.
- If a child is absent on the day of the exam, kindly email info@atsvalley.edu.in and provide a medical certificate for the absence. Only with this documentation will the class test average be considered; otherwise, the child will be marked absent.

SCHOOL'S GUIDELINES

- No student will be exempted from physical exercise and games without a doctor's certificate and prior approval of the school authorities.
- Routine notices will be sent to parents through the student's diary. Parents are requested to check the diary every day and they must be acknowledged.
- After every exam there will be PTM. In PTM students have to come to school in uniform with their Parents/Guardian.
- Guidelines mentioned in the school diary must be read by both parents and to be signed at appropriate place.

CHILD SAFETY POLICY



For us, child safety is of utmost importance

- No mobile phones or other electronic devices inside the classroom.
- No outsiders allowed into the classroom.
- Buses with GPS, CCTV and female conductors/maids.
- CCTV in school premises.
- Female attendants on each floor.
- ID cards for every student.

ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE

- For safety, students allowed to leave school only at the scheduled time.
- Children handed over only after showing a valid collector's card. Please get it issued from the school office.
- Only authorized persons carrying the school issued collector's card allowed to pick up a student.
- **IF PARENTS WISH TO PICK UP THEIR CHILD EARLY, THEY NEED TO** inform the school at least an hour prior (with registered number) or send a note with the student in the morning, stating the time and reason for pick up; or, mail at school info, call the school office and intimate the same.
