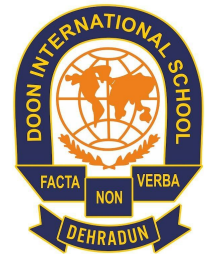

Auditory Learners: Retain information best through listening to lectures, discussions, and speaking.

Reading/Writing Learners: Prefer text-based input, such as reading books, taking notes, and writing lists.

Kinesthetic Learners: Learn through experience, hands-on activities, movement, and tactile manipulation.

Logical (Mathematical): Thrives on logic, patterns, and structure.

Interpersonal: Learns best through social interaction and group work.

Intrapersonal: Prefers self-paced, solitary study.

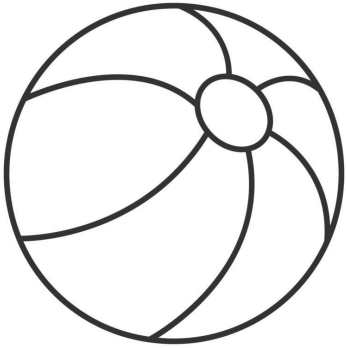
